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TOURNAMENT GUIDELINES

This is a TIMED GRADED DOUBLES tournament. Teams will be graded according to the strongest player. In all cases the decision of the Tournament Director is FINAL.

- 1 Games start & finish on the whistle.
- 2 The rally stops with the whistle - Do not finish rally!
- 3 Each match consists of 3 x 12 minute games
 - Warm up 5 minutes - 2½ mins each team
 - Game 1 = 12 minutes
 - Rest 90 seconds
 - Game 2 = 12 minutes
 - Rest 90 seconds
 - Game 3 = 12 minutes
 - Finish - shake hands - shout your opponents a drink
 - Mark & Referee next match
- 4 Squash Australia approved eyewear is **HIGHLY RECOMMENDED** for all players. Eyewear is **COMPULSORY** for all junior players aged 19 years or under.
- 5 Teams are encouraged to be in matching colours OR matching outfits.
- 6 If points are equal in any game when whistle goes, one more rally will be played to determine the winner of the game.
- 7 If a team is not on the court ready to play at the start of game one, then that team shall forfeit that game and play will recommence at the start of game two.
- 8 All matches including semi finals and finals are played under the same format.



MODIFIED DOUBLES - BASIC RULES

- 1 Squash Australia approved eyewear is **HIGHLY RECOMMENDED** for all players. Eyewear is **COMPULSORY** for all junior players aged 19 years or under.
- 2 Safety First - always call your lets.
- 3 Service & Receiving - Partners must serve and receive from same side throughout each game, but can change at start of each game.
- 4 Alternate team hitting (either player of striking side permitted to hit the ball).
- 5 Strokes may be allowed if interference is in front of the short line.
- 6 Lets & No Lets only for interference behind the short line.
- 7 Only player (not partner) who encounters the interference can appeal (unless both attempting to hit ball).
- 8 You cannot call a let on your own team partner.
