Explanation to players on the Northside of Brisbane

- 1) **Play** in a competition at an affiliated centre: **Squash Power, Taylor Range, University, Wavell**
- 2) Players who decide to play in the non sanctioned competition **solely** will not receive any benefits of affiliation
 - > No pathway
 - > No entitlement to enter State and National events
 - Includes but isn't limited to
 - >> Q Open
 - >> Queensland Junior Championships
 - >> Australian Open
 - >> Australian Closed
 - >> Australian Junior Championships
 - >> National Teams Championship
 - >> National Junior Series
 - > No endorsement to international events
 - > No access to services supplied by State or National Officials
- 3) The eligibility of each player will be checked
 - > Where players played in the **Northside Summer 2008/09 season** forms the base for future decision making
 - > Players who nominate to play at an affiliated centre and also play in the non sanctioned competition will be checked to ensure they meet a minimum playing requirement to ensure they are affiliated on a pro rata basis
 - >> A check will be done on matrix to establish how many times a player has played for the affiliated centre in a 3 month period immediately prior to the closing date for any event
 - >> \$44 will be the equivalent rate used for each Player.
 - Therefore 11 matches in a 3 month period will be the minimum number to qualify.
- 4) Players will need to be affiliated with a centre within their Region
 - > In the main Players will be required to reside on the same side of the river as the competition in which they play
 - > Where the situation is not clear a Player may be required to outline their case to the CEO of Q Squash seeking special consideration by the Board.
 - Hardship of travel will not be a valid reason for special consideration.
 - Caboolture is a Southern Region Centre and no player from the Northside will be able to affiliate with Caboolture to qualify to play in that Region.
